### **CHAPTER 67-23-01**

67-23-01-03. Timelines - Exception to sixty-day timeframe for initial evaluation. The district must evaluate a referred child within sixty calendar days after obtaining parental consent for the evaluation unless:

- 1. An extension is necessary because of extreme weather that prevented or interfered with the evaluation and the extreme weather condition is documented; or
- 2. <u>Either party establishes to the satisfaction of the department that access to a qualified evaluator is so limited that the evaluation cannot occur in the initial sixty days.</u>

The evaluation period, including an extension for the circumstances described above, may not exceed ninety calendar days.
