- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 28-32 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to expiration of administrative rules.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 28-32 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 created and enacted as follows:

Administrative rules expiration. Unless the committee on administrative rules makes
the specific finding that the rule is procedural or interpretive:

- Any rule originally effective before August 1, 1978, becomes void on August 1,
 2001;
- Any rule originally effective after July 31, 1978, and before August 1, 1999,
 becomes void fifteen years after its original effective date or on August 1, 2003,
- 12 whichever is later; and
- 13 3. Any rule originally effective after July 31, 1999, becomes void on August first
- following the next regular session of the legislative assembly which convenes afterthe effective date of the rule.

16 An agency seeking designation of a rule as procedural or interpretive shall present a written

- 17 request for that designation to the committee on administrative rules not less than ninety days
- 18 before the rule is scheduled to become void under this section.
