1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 18-11 of the North Dakota

2 Century Code, relating to alternate firefighters relief association plan benefits; and to provide for

3 retroactive application.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 18-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows:

Service pensions - Formulation of optional plan. With the consent of the governing
body of the city involved, and in substitution for a pension payment schedule provided in section
18-11-15, a firefighters relief association may adopt a monthly service pension plan for
members of the association as provided in this section.

- Retirement date is the first day of the month next following the month in which the
 member attains the age of fifty-five years.
- Retirement benefits for members reaching the retirement date equal an annual amount, payable monthly, comprised of a service benefit that equals two and thirty-three hundredths percent of a first-class firefighter's salary at the time of the member's retirement multiplied by the number of years of service employment up to a maximum of thirty years.
- Upon termination of employment after completing ten years of eligible employment
 but before the retirement date, a member is eligible to receive deferred vested
 retirement benefits payable commencing on the retirement date equal to one
 hundred percent of the member's accrued benefits.
- 4. Members participating in a firefighters relief association paying a monthly service
 pension to members of the association under this section must serve ten years
 before they are eligible for a service pension.

- 1 5. Upon the recommendation of the association's actuary, the association may
- 2 implement postretirement adjustments on an actuarially sound basis to pensioners
- 3 and beneficiaries under the plan.
- 4 SECTION 2. RETROACTIVE APPLICATION OF ACT. This Act is retroactive to
- 5 January 1, 1998.
