BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subdivision a of subsection 1 of section 39-03.1-10.1 of 7 the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 8 If the contributor has less than ten years of service at termination of 9 employment, the refund is payable either on application of the contributor, or, 10 if within thirty days after termination the contributor has not provided a written 11 statement to the board waiving the refund and requesting the contributor's 12 account remain in the fund, automatically in January of the following calendar 13 year. 14 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subdivision a of subsection 4 of section 39-03.1-11 of the 15 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 16 Normal retirement benefits for all contributors reaching the normal retirement 17 date are payable monthly, and are: The first twenty-five years of credited service multiplied by three and 18 (1) 19 twenty-five forty hundredths percent of final average salary. 20 (2) All years in excess of twenty-five years of credited service multiplied by 21 one and three-fourths percent of final average salary. 22 (3)All contributors who retired before August 1, 1997 1999, are entitled to 23 receive benefits equal to three and twenty-five forty hundredths percent 24 of final average salary multiplied by the first twenty-five years of

1	credited service, plus one and three-fourths percent of final average
2	salary multiplied by credited service in excess of twenty-five years, with
3	the increased benefits payable beginning August 1, 1997 <u>1999</u> .
