- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 53-06.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to local gaming enforcement grants.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 53-06.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Local gaming enforcement grants. The attorney general, through the state treasurer, shall make quarterly payments to counties and cities. These payments must be from funds appropriated to the attorney general for local gaming enforcement grants. The payments to a city must be in proportion to the adjusted gross proceeds within that city, for sites within city limits, to the total adjusted gross proceeds for all sites within all cities in the state. The payments to a county must be in proportion to the adjusted gross proceeds for sites outside city limits in the state. The calculation of the amounts to be distributed to counties and cities for local gaming enforcement grants is to be based on the prior quarter's actual adjusted gross proceeds. The attorney general may make a payment to a city or county pursuant to this section only if the amount owed to a city or county for that quarter is at least ten dollars. A city or county receiving funds under this section shall use the funds for expenses connected with gaming enforcement within the city or county.
