- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the agriculture
- 2 commissioner; and to amend and reenact section 4-01-21 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 3 relating to the salary of the agriculture commissioner.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the	
6	funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state	
7	treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and	
8	other income, to the agriculture commissioner for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the	
9	agriculture commissioner, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005,	
10	as follows:

1 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 4-01-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is 2 amended and reenacted as follows: 3 4-01-21. Salary of agriculture commissioner. The annual salary of the agriculture 4 commissioner is sixty-six sixty-nine thousand five eight hundred nine seventy-four dollars 5 through December 31, 2001 2003, sixty-eight seventy thousand five hundred four 6 seventy-three dollars through June 30 December 31, 2002 2004, and sixty nine seventy-one 7 thousand eight nine hundred seventy-four eighty-four dollars thereafter. 8 SECTION 3. ESTIMATED INCOME - ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND 9 **PROTECTION FUND.** The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum 10 of \$2,499,215 or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the environment and 11 rangeland protection fund for the purpose of defraying the expenses of various agriculture 12 department programs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005. 13 SECTION 4. ANHYDROUS AMMONIA STORAGE INSPECTION FUND. The 14 estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$156,359, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the anhydrous ammonia storage inspection fund for the 15 16 purpose of defraying the expenses of regulating anhydrous ammonia storage facilities, for the 17 biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005. 18 **SECTION 5. ESTIMATED INCOME - GAME AND FISH FUND.** The estimated income 19 line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$550,000, or so much of the sum as may 20 be necessary, from the game and fish department operating fund for the purpose of defraying the expenses of various agriculture department programs for the biennium beginning July 1, 21 22 2003, and ending June 30, 2005.
