- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for the commitment of individuals addicted to controlled
- 2 substances; and to provide a penalty.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. Commitment of individuals addicted to methamphetamine or other

5 controlled substances - Penalty.

- Subject to the commitment procedures provided for in chapter 25-03.1, upon
 petition to the court by the individual or any interested party, the court may order an
 individual who is addicted to methamphetamine or other controlled substances to
 participate in and complete an appropriate extensive inpatient drug treatment
 program. The court may order any individual who is reasonably able to do so to
 contribute to the cost of the individual's own placement in a drug treatment
 program.
- 2. Upon the issuance of an order imposing the treatment program as provided in
 subsection 1, the department of human services shall notify the drug treatment
 program provider designated to provide the drug treatment program. Within thirty
 days of receiving that notice, the drug treatment program provider shall prepare a
 treatment plan and forward it to the court.
- The individual is guilty of a class C felony if the court finds that the individual
 willfully violated the conditions of the order issued under this section.
