- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the establishment of an alternatives-to-abortion services program; to
- 3 provide for reports to the legislative council; to provide an appropriation; and to provide an
- 4 expiration date.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Alternatives-to-abortion services program. Before January 1, 2006, the department of human services shall establish and operate a program to provide alternatives-to-abortion services. The program must be outcome-based with positive outcome-based results. For purposes of this Act, "alternatives-to-abortion services" are those services that promote childbirth instead of abortion by providing information, counseling, and support services that assist pregnant women or women who believe they may be pregnant to choose childbirth and to make informed decisions regarding the choice of adoption or parenting with respect to their children.

SECTION 2. REPORT TO LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL. During the 2005-06 interim, the department of human services shall make periodic reports to the legislative council regarding the status of the alternatives-to-abortion services program, the first of which must be made by December 1, 2005.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys from special funds derived from federal funds and other income from the temporary assistance for needy families program, the sum of \$500,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of human services for the purpose of establishing and operating an alternatives-to-abortion services program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending

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- 1 June 30, 2007. The department shall seek sources of funding for the program through the
- 2 federal office of faith-based and community initiatives.
- 3 SECTION 4. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act is effective through June 30, 2007, and
- 4 after that date is ineffective.
