1 A concurrent resolution to amend and reenact section 9 of article III of the Constitution of North

- 2 Dakota, relating to the biennial legislative approval of general fund expenditures that are
- 3 mandated by an initiated constitutional amendment if the mandated general fund expenditure
- 4 exceeds a certain amount.

### 5 STATEMENT OF INTENT

- 6 This measure requires biennial legislative approval of any state general fund expenditure that is
- 7 mandated by an initiated constitutional amendment if the amount of the mandated expenditure
- 8 is greater than one percent of the state general fund revenue for the previous biennium.

## 10 **CONCURRING THEREIN:**

- 11 That the following proposed amendment to section 9 of article III of the Constitution of North
- 12 Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the
- 13 general election to be held in 2020, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the
- 14 Constitution of North Dakota.
- 15 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 9 of article III of the Constitution of North Dakota is
- 16 amended and reenacted as follows:

## 17 Section 9.

- 18 <u>1.</u> A constitutional amendment may be proposed by initiative petition. If signed by
- electors equal in number to four percent of the resident population of the state at the
- 20 last federal decennial census, the petition may be submitted to the secretary of state.
- All other provisions relating to initiative measures apply hereto.
- 22 <u>2. Notwithstanding section 8, for any constitutional amendment that requires the</u>
- 23 expenditure of moneys from the state general fund in a sum greater than one percent
- of the state general fund revenue for the previous biennium, the expenditure of those

- 1 <u>funds must be approved by the legislative assembly and signed by the governor in</u>
- 2 <u>each succeeding biennium.</u>
