1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the agriculture

2 commissioner; and to provide for transfersa transfer; and to amend and reenact sections

3 4.1-16-06 and 4.1-16-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to beekeeper license fees.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 6 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 7 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 8 other income, to the agriculture commissioner for the purpose of defraying the expenses of 9 the agriculture commissioner, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 10 2019, as follows:

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1	The 2017-19 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the		
2	2019-21 biennium. The agriculture commissioner shall report to the appropriations committees		
3	of the sixty-sixth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium		
4	beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.		
5	SECTION 4. TRANSFER - ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION FUND -		
6	MINOR USE PESTICIDE FUND. The agriculture commissioner shall transfer \$325,000 from		
7	the environment and rangeland protection fund to the minor use pesticide fund during the		
8	biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.		
9	SECTION 5. ESTIMATED INCOME - ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION		
10	FUND. The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of		
11	\$6,403,714\$6,446,503 from the environment and rangeland protection fund for the purpose of		
12	defraying the expenses of various department of agriculture programs, for the biennium		
13	beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.		
14	SECTION 6. ESTIMATED INCOME - GAME AND FISH FUND. The estimated income line		
15	item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$499,585 \$614,430 from the game and fish		
16	department operating fund for the purpose of defraying the expenses of various department		
17	of agriculture programs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30,		
18	2019.		
19	SECTION 7. ESTIMATED INCOME - STATE WATER COMMISSION - TRANSFER. The		
20	estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$250,000\$125,000 which		
21	the state water commission shall transfer to the agriculture commissioner for the wildlife		
22	services program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.		
23	SECTION 8. WATERBANK PROGRAM - MATCHING FUNDS. The salaries and wages line		
24	item in section 1 of this Act includes \$50,000 from the general fund for matching funds for the		
25	North Dakota outdoor heritage fund grant provided for the waterbank program.		
26	SECTION 9. TRANSFER - STRATEGIC INVESTMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS FUND -		
27	FEDERAL ENVIRONMENTAL LAW IMPACT REVIEW FUND - ESTIMATED INCOME. The		
28	estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes a sum of \$1,000,000, which the		
29	office of management and budget shall transfer from the strategic investment and		
30	improvements fund to the federal environmental law impact review fund for the use by the		
31	agriculture commissioner, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.		

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1	SECTION 10. ESTIMATED INCOME - PIPELINE RESTORATION AND RECLAMATION.
2	The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$200,000 from the
3	abandoned oil and gas well plugging and site reclamation fund for the purpose of defraying the
4	expenses of the pipeline restoration and reclamation program, for the biennium beginning
5	July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.
6	SECTION 11. AMENDMENT. Section 4.1-16-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
7	amended and reenacted as follows:
8	4.1-16-06. License fee.
9	The fee for a beekeeper's license is five dollars. All fees collected must be deposited in the
10	agriculture commissioner operating fund.
11	SECTION 12. AMENDMENT. Section 4.1-16-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is
12	amended and reenacted as follows:
13	4.1-16-07. Colony assessment.
14	In addition to the license fee required by section 4.1-16-06, an applicant for a license must
15	submit a colony assessment in an amount equal to fifteen cents multiplied by the maximum
16	number of colonies listed in the application. All fees collected must be deposited in the
17	agriculture commissioner operating fund.
