


Major Related Legislation

Senate Bill No. 2070 - This bill provides that administrative law judges employed by the Office of Administrative Hearings before August 1, 1995, need not be attorneys at law and may be designated by the director of the Office of Administrative Hearings to preside at any administrative proceeding or adjudicative proceeding.
