## **Item Description**

**Enrollment** - At the end of the 2007 Legislative Assembly, the University of North Dakota's FTE student enrollment projection for the fall 2007 semester was 11,381.

**Tuition collections** - The University of North Dakota estimated tuition revenue of \$69,400,000 for the 2007-08 fiscal year.

**One-time funding** - The Legislative Assembly identified \$28,382,068 from the general fund and \$7,583,315 from the permanent oil tax trust fund for one-time funding items for the North Dakota University System, of which \$3,628,330 from the general fund is for extraordinary repairs, \$1,980,000 from the general fund is for O'Kelly Hall and Ireland Laboratory renovation projects, and \$200,000 from the general fund is for the Nursing Education Consortium at the University of North Dakota. These amounts are not to be considered part of the institution's base budget for preparing the 2009-11 executive budget, and the University of North Dakota is to report to the Appropriations Committees during the 2009 legislative session on the use of this funding.

**Capital assets** - The University of North Dakota received a capital assets appropriation of \$85,828,875. The following is a summary of the funding:

## Status/Result

The University of North Dakota fall 2007 semester FTE enrollment was 10,967, 414 less than estimated.

The University of North Dakota's current estimate for tuition collections for the 2007-08 fiscal year is \$69,300,000, \$100,000 less than projected.

The University of North Dakota College of Nursing is administering a Nursing Education Consortium. As of May 2008 the consortium has met 10 times to discuss areas of concern relating to nursing education and rural health. The consortium has spent \$100,000 of the funding on training, grant writing, and meeting expenses and anticipates spending the remainder of the funding by the end of the 2007-09 biennium.
