House Bill No. 1152 - Department of Human Services - House Action

This bill provides an appropriation of \$3,454,061, of which \$1,527,802 is from the general fund and \$1,926,259 is from federal funds, to the Department of Human Services for providing Medicaid supplemental payments to critical access hospitals.

House Bill No. 1152 - Department of Human Services - Senate Action

Sections are added that provide intent regarding Medicaid supplemental payments and provide for Legislative Management studies of patient-centered medical homes and health care delivery. Language is also included to provide that funding included in the bill for Medicaid supplemental payments to critical access hospitals is considered one-time funding.

House Bill No. 1152 - Department of Human Services - Conference Committee Action

Sections are added that provide for Legislative Management studies of patient-centered medical homes and health care delivery. These studies were also added by the Senate. Language is also included to provide that funding included in the bill for Medicaid supplemental payments to critical access hospitals is considered one-time funding. This language was also added by the Senate. The section of legislative intent added by the Senate regarding Medicaid supplemental payments was not added by the conference committee.
