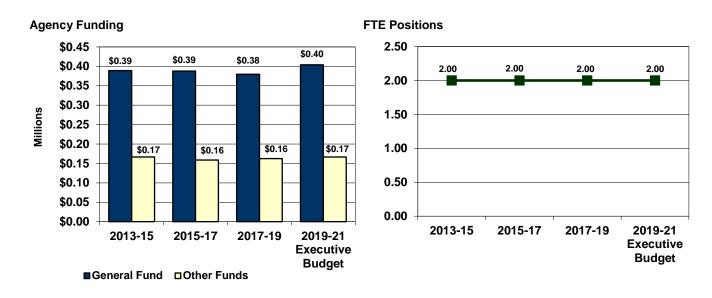

1. Adds funding for state employee salary and benefit increases, of which \$16,110 is for salary increases, \$7,558 is for health insurance increases, and \$2,101 is for retirement contribution	\$23,774	<b>Sther Funds</b> \$1,995	\$25,769

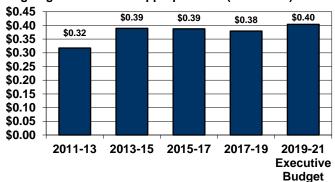

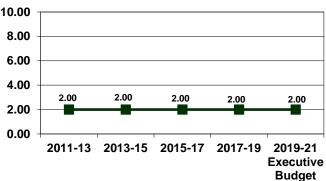
