1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subdivision a of subsection 1 of section 43-25-07 of the
2 North Dakota Century Code, relating to school of massage therapy accreditation standards.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision a of subsection 1 of section 43-25-07 of the
5 1997 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 6 a. Presents a diploma or credentials issued by a school of massage that meets
- 7 the standards set by the board; which may not be less than the standards of
- 8 the American massage therapy association commission on massage therapy
- 9 accreditation but which must require at least seven hundred fifty hours of
- 10 supervised instruction; or if the board has not adopted standards, the school
- 11 of massage meets the curriculum guidelines of the American massage
- 12 therapy association commission on massage therapy accreditation and the
- 13 school requires at least seven hundred fifty hours of supervised instruction.
- 14 Any student enrolled in a massage school on or before the effective date of
- 15 this Act satisfies the requirements in this subdivision if the student presents a
- 16 diploma or credentials issued by a school of massage that requires at least
- 17 five hundred hours of instruction.
