

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3010

1 A concurrent resolution urging the Citizens Stamp Advisory Committee to approve for release a
2 stamp honoring Louis L'Amour.

3 **WHEREAS**, Louis L'Amour was born in Jamestown, North Dakota, March 22, 1908; and

4 **WHEREAS**, prior to his death in 1988, Louis L'Amour published more than 400 short
5 stories and 100 novels, wrote 65 television scripts, and sold over 30 stories to the motion
6 picture industry, including "Hondo" starring John Wayne; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the public has purchased over 50 million Louis L'Amour books making him
8 the fastest selling novelist in America; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Louis L'Amour was awarded North Dakota's Theodore Roosevelt Rough
10 Rider Award, the highest recognition a present or former North Dakotan may receive from the
11 State, for achieving national recognition for a genuine achievement of lasting significance which
12 reflects credit and honor upon North Dakota and its citizens;

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
14 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

15 That the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly urges the Citizens Stamp Advisory Committee
16 to approve for release a stamp honoring Louis L'Amour; and

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of State forward a copy of this
18 resolution to each member of the Citizens Stamp Advisory Committee and to each member of
19 the North Dakota Congressional Delegation.
