

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3014

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the disparity in prices and the
2 inconsistency in the registration of agricultural pesticides.

3 **WHEREAS**, the agricultural sector is highly dependent on the availability of agricultural
4 pesticides; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Canadian and United States governmental entities are involved in the
6 approval and registration of agricultural pesticides; and

7 **WHEREAS**, chemicals approved by the Canadian government might not be approved
8 by the United States government; and

9 **WHEREAS**, chemicals approved by the Canadian government and not approved by the
10 United States government are used on food products that enter the stream of commerce in the
11 United States; and

12 **WHEREAS**, chemicals approved by the United States and Canada are available to
13 Canadian producers at a price much more favorable than that enjoyed by United States
14 producers;

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
16 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

17 That the Legislative Council study the disparity in prices and inconsistency in the
18 registration of agricultural pesticides; and

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
20 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
21 the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly.
