

**HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3034**

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the impact on state and local  
2 government entities and on businesses of having the state divided between two time zones.

3 **WHEREAS**, the state is divided between the central time zone and the mountain time  
4 zone; and

5 **WHEREAS**, because the state is divided between time zones, state and local  
6 government entities and businesses are affected by time changes and in areas near the time  
7 zone boundary are particularly impacted by the time changes; and

8 **WHEREAS**, because the impact of the time zone division has not been fully examined,  
9 a thorough study of the impact is necessary to aid in making determinations regarding the  
10 changing of time zone boundaries;

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**  
12 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

13 That the Legislative Council study the impact on state and local government entities and  
14 on businesses of having the state divided between two time zones; and

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and  
16 recommendations together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations to  
17 the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly.
