

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3052

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study how the transportation
2 infrastructure and services delivery system in this state affect the price for agricultural
3 commodities grown or raised in this state.

4 **WHEREAS**, this state is centrally located in the United States and contains the
5 geographical center of North America; and

6 **WHEREAS**, agriculture is integral to the economy of this state and the successful
7 marketing of agricultural products depends upon the access to and cost of transportation for
8 agricultural commodities; and

9 **WHEREAS**, most of the agricultural commodities grown or raised in this state are
10 exported for consumption outside this state;

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
12 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

13 That the Legislative Council study how the transportation infrastructure and services
14 delivery system in this state affect the price for agricultural commodities grown or raised in this
15 state; and

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
17 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
18 the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly.
