

HOUSE BILL NO. 1017

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of job service North
2 Dakota.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
5 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in
6 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal
7 funds and other income, to job service North Dakota for the purpose of defraying its expenses,
8 for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001, as follows:

10 Operating expenses	15,268,989
11 Equipment	887,100
12 Capital improvements	493,553
13 Grants	7,977,253
14 Work Force 2000	<u>2,000,676</u>
15 Total all funds	\$58,354,767
16 Less estimated income	<u>56,354,767</u>
17 Total general fund appropriation	\$2,000,000

18 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** All federal funds received by job service North
19 Dakota in excess of those funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act are hereby appropriated
20 for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001.

21 **SECTION 3. WORK FORCE 2000 ALLOCATIONS.** For the year beginning July 1,
22 1999, a minimum of \$150,000, of the \$2,000,676 provided for work force 2000, must be
23 available for projects in areas of the state that are not within five miles [8.05 kilometers] of any
