ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1020

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state board for
2 vocational and technical education.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
5 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in
6 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal
7 funds and other income, to the state board for vocational and technical education for the
8 purpose of defraying the expenses of its various divisions, for the biennium beginning July 1,
9 1999, and ending June 30, 2001, as follows:

19 **SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - FARM MANAGEMENT PROGRAM FEES.** It is
20 the intent of the fifty-sixth legislative assembly that all fees collected for farm management
21 programs pursuant to sections 6-09.10-02.1 and 6-09.10-06 be transferred to the state board
22 for vocational and technical education. The state board for vocational and technical education
23 shall distribute the fees as it determines necessary to state agencies and organizations
24 involved in providing farm management programs.
