

**FIRST ENGROSSMENT
with Conference Committee Amendments**

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1022

Introduced by

Appropriations Committee

(At the request of the Governor)

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for capital projects of various state departments
2 and institutions; to authorize the industrial commission to issue and sell bonds for capital
3 projects; to provide an appropriation; and to declare an emergency.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. PROJECT AUTHORIZATIONS.** The industrial commission, acting as the
6 North Dakota building authority, shall arrange for the funding of the projects authorized in this
7 section, hereby declared to be in the public interest, through the issuance of evidences of
8 indebtedness under chapter 54-17.2, during the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending
9 June 30, 2001. The proceeds of the evidences of indebtedness and other available funds are
10 hereby appropriated during the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001, for
11 the following projects:

18 The industrial commission shall issue evidences of indebtedness under this section with
19 the condition that lease rental payments need not begin until July 1, 2001. This authority of the
20 industrial commission to issue evidences of indebtedness ends June 30, 2001, but the
21 industrial commission may continue to exercise all other powers granted to it under chapter
22 54-17.2 and this Act and to comply with any covenants entered into before that date.

23 North Dakota state university may obtain and utilize federal funds to assist in the
24 construction of an animal research facility at North Dakota state university. There is hereby

1 appropriated to North Dakota state university the sum of \$2,207,500, or so much of the sum as
2 may be necessary, from any federal or other funds that may become available for this project
3 for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001.

4 The department of corrections and rehabilitation may obtain and utilize federal funds to
5 assist in the renovation of pine cottage at the youth correctional center. There is hereby
6 appropriated to the department of corrections and rehabilitation the sum of \$500,000, or so
7 much of the sum as may be necessary, from any federal or other funds that may become
8 available for this project for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001.

9 Grand total special funds appropriation \$10,890,000

10 **SECTION 2. BOND ISSUANCE REPAYMENT RESPONSIBILITY.** Of the total
11 amount of evidences of indebtedness issued under the provisions of section 1 of this Act, a
12 total of \$3,000,000 must be available from nongeneral fund sources to assist in the retirement
13 of the evidences of indebtedness, issued for the project costs associated with construction of
14 the projects authorized by this Act:

15 UND-Williston \$3,000,000

16 The university of North Dakota-Williston shall provide \$1,500,000 of funding towards the
17 health and wellness center addition before construction may begin. The remaining \$1,500,000
18 of local responsibility is to be paid in ten annual payments of \$150,000.

19 If the project is reduced in size and funding, the local responsibility is to be reduced
20 proportionately.

21 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
