ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2120

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 16.1-10-06 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to electioneering on election day.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 16.1-10-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **16.1-10-06. Electioneering on election day - Penalty.** Any person asking, soliciting,
7 or in any manner trying to induce or persuade, any voter on an election day to vote or refrain
8 from voting for any candidate or the candidates or ticket of any political party or organization, or
9 any measure submitted to the people, in any polling place or within one hundred feet
10 [30.48 meters] from any entrance leading into a polling place, is guilty of an infraction. The
11 display upon motor vehicles of adhesive signs which are not readily removable and which
12 promote the candidacy of any individual, any political party, or a vote upon any measure, and
13 political advertisements promoting the candidacy of any individual, political party, or a vote
14 upon any measure which are displayed on fixed permanent billboards, may not, however, be
15 deemed a violation of this section.
