

**HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3026**

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability  
2 of implementing a state college savings plan providing a state tuition tax credit or providing for a  
3 prepaid college tuition program.

4 **WHEREAS**, the cost of a college or university education has risen faster than family  
5 income, jeopardizing the ability of many families to afford higher education for their children;  
6 and

7 **WHEREAS**, an educated populace is a required element to support our elective  
8 democracy, to improve agriculture, to provide an educated work force, and to promote  
9 economic growth for this state; and

10 **WHEREAS**, many other states have developed and implemented programs to promote  
11 savings for college, including tuition tax credit programs and prepaid college tuition programs;

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**  
13 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

14 That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of implementing a state  
15 college savings plan providing a state tuition tax credit or providing for a prepaid college tuition  
16 program; and

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and  
18 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to  
19 the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly.
