

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3072

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the state of the law in this
2 state and other states dealing with the administration of discipline in public schools.

3 **WHEREAS**, the administration of discipline in public schools is necessary to create a
4 favorable learning environment for students; and

5 **WHEREAS**, there has been an increase in public schools of unacceptable and
6 disruptive behavior which is related to a lack of discipline and lack of respect of authority by
7 students; and

8 **WHEREAS**, this unacceptable and disruptive behavior leads to a disruption of the
9 educational environment and leads to an inordinate expenditure of human and monetary
10 resources to deal with this behavior;

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
12 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

13 That the Legislative Council study the state of the law in this state and other states
14 dealing with the administration of discipline in public schools; and

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
16 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
17 the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly.
