1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 61-16.1 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to maintenance of natural watercourses and debrisment of bridges and
3 low water crossings.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 61-16.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is
6 created and enacted as follows:

7 **Watercourses, bridges, and low water crossings.** A water resource board may
8 undertake the snagging, clearing, and maintaining of natural watercourses and the debrisment
9 of bridges and low water crossings. The board may finance the project in whole or in part with
10 funds raised through the collection of a special assessment levied against the land and
11 premises within the watershed benefited by the project. All provisions of this chapter apply to
12 assessments levied under this section except:

- 13 1. An assessment may not exceed fifty cents per acre [.40 hectare] annually on
14 agricultural lands and may not exceed fifty cents annually for each five hundred
15 dollars of taxable valuation of nonagricultural property; and
- 16 2. No action is required for the establishment of the assessment district or the
17 assessments except the board must approve the project and assessment by a vote
18 of two-thirds of the members and the board of county commissioners of the county
19 must approve and levy the assessments to be made by a vote of two-thirds of its
20 members.
