1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 16.1-12-02.2 of the North Dakota Century
2 Code, relating to counting of write-in votes.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 16.1-12-02.2 of the 1999 Supplement to the
5 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **16.1-12-02.2. Counting of write-in votes** ~~Certificate of candidacy by write-in~~
7 ~~candidates in political subdivision elections.~~

8 4. An election board or canvassing board ~~may not~~ shall count any write-in vote ~~for~~
9 ~~any:~~

10 a. ~~Person who is required to file a certificate of write-in candidacy under this~~
11 ~~section but who has not filed a certificate of candidacy and been certified as a~~
12 ~~write-in candidate.~~

13 b. ~~Fictitious~~ cast in a county, city, school district, or other political subdivision
14 election. An election or canvassing board is not required to count any write-in
15 vote for a fictitious person, nonperson, or person clearly not eligible to qualify
16 for the office for which the vote was cast.

17 e. ~~Statement concerning the candidates.~~

18 2. ~~A person who intends to be a write-in candidate for president of the United States~~
19 ~~at the presidential preference contest or for statewide or judicial district office at~~
20 ~~any election shall file a certificate of write-in candidacy with the secretary of state~~
21 ~~by four p.m. on the twenty first day before the contest or election. The certificate~~
22 ~~must contain the name and address of the candidate and be signed by the~~

23 ~~candidate. Before the thirteenth day before the contest or election, the secretary of~~

- 1 ~~state shall certify the names of the candidates to each county auditor as write-in~~
2 ~~candidates.~~
- 3 ~~3. A person who intends to be a write-in candidate at the general election for~~
4 ~~president of the United States shall file a certificate of write-in candidacy with the~~
5 ~~secretary of state by four p.m. on the twenty-first day before the general election.~~
6 ~~The certificate must contain the names and addresses of the candidates for~~
7 ~~presidential electors for that presidential candidate and a certification of~~
8 ~~acceptance signed by each candidate for elector. The candidate shall sign the~~
9 ~~certificate. The certificate may also include the name and address of a candidate~~
10 ~~for vice president of the United States and a certification of acceptance signed by~~
11 ~~that candidate. The secretary of state shall prescribe the form of the certificate of~~
12 ~~write-in candidacy and the certification of acceptance. Before the thirteenth day~~
13 ~~before the election, the secretary of state shall certify the names of the presidential~~
14 ~~candidates and the presidential electors to each county auditor as write-in~~
15 ~~candidates.~~
- 16 ~~4. A person who intends to be a write-in candidate for any legislative district office~~
17 ~~shall file a certificate of write-in candidacy with the election officer with whom the~~
18 ~~candidate would otherwise file to have the candidate's name placed on the ballot.~~
19 ~~The certificate must contain the name, address, and signature of the candidate.~~
20 ~~Certificates must be filed by four p.m. on the fourth day before the election. When~~
21 ~~the candidate files a certificate, the candidate also shall file the contribution~~
22 ~~statement provided for under section 16.1-08.1-02 complete through the day of the~~
23 ~~filing of the certificate.~~
- 24 ~~5. A certificate under this section is not required when:~~
- 25 ~~a. No names will appear on the ballot for an office;~~
- 26 ~~b. The number of candidates appearing on the ballot for an office is less than the~~
27 ~~number to be elected; or~~
- 28 ~~e. The number of candidates appearing on the ballot for a party office is less~~
29 ~~than the number of nominations a party is entitled to make. When certificates~~
30 ~~of write-in candidacy are not required under this chapter, all write-in votes~~
31 ~~must be counted.~~
