1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 64-02-10 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to fees for testing or calibrating weighing and measuring devices.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 64-02-10 of the 1999 Supplement to the North
5 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **64-02-10. Fees to test or calibrate weighing and measuring devices.** The
7 commission shall collect the following fees to:

20 When a rejected weighing or measuring device has been reconditioned or replaced by
21 new equipment, it must be retested and certified before being put into use except as otherwise
22 provided by rule. The fee for retest and certification is the same as for the first test and
23 certification.

24 When a test of a weighing or measuring device is required in addition to the regularly
25 scheduled annual test, the commission shall charge a fee equal to the cost of operating the
26 motor vehicle used in conducting the test. The mileage charges, as determined by the
27 commission, must be in addition to the regular test fee and calculated to cover the costs of the
28 additional travel. Where a test has been requested and the person requesting it fails to appear
29 or to have the weighing or measuring device ready for testing at the arranged time, there is a
30 charge of nine dollars a quarter hour for the time between the arranged time and the time at
31 which the test can begin.
