1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to title 39 of the North Dakota Century
2 Code, relating to theft of motor fuels; and to provide a penalty.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to title 39 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and
5 enacted as follows:

6 **Nonpayment for motor fuels - Penalty.**

- 7 1. For a theft offense in violation of chapter 12.1-23 which involves a person who
8 leaves the premises of an establishment at which motor fuel is offered for retail
9 sale after motor fuel was dispensed into the fuel tank of a motor vehicle that that
10 person drove away without having made due payment or authorized charge for the
11 motor fuel dispensed, the court may:
- 12 a. Upon a person's second conviction, order the suspension of the person's
13 driving privileges for up to three months; and
 - 14 b. Upon a person's third or subsequent conviction, order the suspension of the
15 person's driving privileges for up to six months.
- 16 2. As used in this section, "conviction" means a final conviction without regard to
17 whether sentence was suspended or deferred or probation was granted after the
18 conviction. Forfeiture of bail, bond, or collateral deposited to secure a defendant's
19 appearance in court, which forfeiture has not been vacated, is equivalent to
20 conviction.
