This bill proposes to increase the annual license fee for grain warehouses and grain buyers by \$50 per year. The annual license fee for grain warehouses ranges from \$250 to \$500 per year depending on the size of the facility. The fee for facility-based grain buyers is \$250. The fee for roving grain buyers is \$150. Increasing these fees by \$50 would generate approximately \$48,000 per biennium for the general fund. The increase was recommended by the State Auditor in a March 2000 audit report.
