## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
5	funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
6	treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
7	other income, to job service North Dakota for the purpose of defraying its expenses, for the
8	biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005, as follows:
9	Salaries and wages \$34,411,497
10	Operating expenses 14,529,359
11	Capital assets 39,684
12	Grants 7,617,792
13	Work force 2000 <u>2,002,861</u>
14	Total all funds \$58,601,193
15	Less estimated income <u>56,598,332</u>
16	Total general fund appropriation \$2,002,861
17	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. All federal funds received by job service North
18	Dakota in excess of those funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act are appropriated, for the
19	biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005.
20	SECTION 3. WORK FORCE 2000 ALLOCATIONS. For the year beginning July 1,
21	2003, a minimum of \$150,000 of the \$2,002,861 provided for work force 2000, is to be available
22	for projects in areas of the state that are not within five miles [8.05 kilometers] of a city with a
23	population of more than eight thousand. Any work force 2000 funds remaining after June 30,

2004, may be used for projects in any area of the state.
