ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1023

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for capital projects of various state departments;

2 to provide an appropriation for state facility energy improvement capital projects of various state

3 departments and institutions; to authorize the industrial commission to issue and sell evidences

4 of indebtedness for capital projects; and to declare an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. PROJECT AUTHORIZATIONS. The industrial commission, acting as the 7 North Dakota building authority, shall arrange for the funding of the projects authorized in this 8 section, declared to be in the public interest, through the issuance of evidences of 9 indebtedness under chapter 54-17.2, beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending 10 June 30, 2005. The industrial commission shall issue evidences of indebtedness under this 11 section with the condition that lease rental payments need not begin until July 1, 2005. The 12 authority of the industrial commission to issue evidences of indebtedness under this section 13 ends June 30, 2005, but the industrial commission may continue to exercise all other powers 14 granted to it under chapter 54-17.2 and this Act and comply with any covenants entered into 15 before that date. The proceeds of the evidences of indebtedness and other available funds are 16 appropriated to the agencies listed in this section, beginning with the effective date of this Act 17 and ending June 30, 2005, for the following projects: 18 \$614,865 State department of health east laboratory remodeling 19 960,000 State department of health morgue and storage annex construction 20 Department of corrections and rehabilitation - James River 2,662,890 21 correctional center phase II 22 \$4,237,755 Total special funds appropriation 23 The bonding authority provided for the state department of health east laboratory 24 remodeling project in the amount of \$614,865 must be reduced by any available moneys the

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1	department is able to use from the funding provided by the centers for disease control and
2	prevention and health resources and services administration for bioterrorism programs.
3	SECTION 2. STATE FACILITY ENERGY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT
4	AUTHORIZATIONS. The industrial commission, acting as the North Dakota building authority,
5	shall arrange for the funding of the projects authorized in this section, which are described in a
6	report dated August 29, 2002, filed with the governor by the division of community services of
7	the department of commerce, and which are declared to be in the public interest, through the
8	issuance of evidences of indebtedness under chapter 54-17.2 and section 54-44.5-08,
9	beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2005. The authority of the
10	industrial commission to issue evidences of indebtedness under this section ends June 30,
11	2005, but the industrial commission may continue to exercise all other powers granted to it
12	under chapter 54-17.2, section 54-44.5-08, and this Act, and comply with any covenants
13	entered into before that date. The proceeds of the evidences of indebtedness and other
14	available funds are appropriated to the agencies and institutions listed in this section, beginning
15	with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2005, for the following projects:

21	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
