1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for capital projects of various state departments;

2 to provide an appropriation for the state facility energy improvement capital project of the

3 department of corrections and rehabilitation; to authorize the industrial commission to issue and

4 sell evidences of indebtedness for capital projects; to provide for a legislative council study; and

5 to declare an emergency.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

7 SECTION 1. PROJECT AUTHORIZATIONS. The industrial commission, acting as the 8 North Dakota building authority, shall arrange for the funding of the projects authorized in this 9 section, declared to be in the public interest, through the issuance of evidences of 10 indebtedness under chapter 54-17.2, beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending 11 June 30, 2005. The industrial commission shall issue evidences of indebtedness under this 12 section with the condition that lease rental payments need not begin until July 1, 2005. The 13 authority of the industrial commission to issue evidences of indebtedness under this section 14 ends June 30, 2005, but the industrial commission may continue to exercise all other powers 15 granted to it under chapter 54-17.2 and this Act and comply with any covenants entered into 16 before that date. The proceeds of the evidences of indebtedness and other available funds are 17 appropriated to the agencies listed in this section, beginning with the effective date of this Act 18 and ending June 30, 2005, for the following projects: \$614,865 19 State department of health east laboratory remodeling 20 State department of health morgue and storage annex construction 960,000 21 Department of corrections and rehabilitation - James River 2,662,890 22 correctional center phase II

23 Department of corrections and rehabilitation - <u>430,000</u>

3 The bonding authority provided for the state department of health east laboratory 4 remodeling project in the amount of \$614,865 must be reduced by any available moneys the 5 department is able to use from the funding provided by the centers for disease control and 6 prevention and health resources and services administration for bioterrorism programs. SECTION 2. STATE FACILITY ENERGY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT 7 8 **AUTHORIZATIONS.** The industrial commission, acting as the North Dakota building authority, 9 shall arrange for the funding of the projects authorized in this section, which are described in a 10 report dated August 29, 2002, filed with the governor by the division of community services of 11 the department of commerce, and which are declared to be in the public interest, through the 12 issuance of evidences of indebtedness under chapter 54-17.2 and section 54-44.5-08, 13 beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2005. The authority of the 14 industrial commission to issue evidences of indebtedness under this section ends June 30, 15 2005, but the industrial commission may continue to exercise all other powers granted to it 16 under chapter 54-17.2, section 54-44.5-08, and this Act, and comply with any covenants 17 entered into before that date. The proceeds of the evidences of indebtedness and other 18 available funds are appropriated to the agencies and institutions listed in this section, beginning 19 with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2005, for the following projects: 20 Department of corrections and rehabilitation - Missouri River \$105,326 21 correctional center 22 Total special funds appropriation \$105.326

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY - CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION LEASE PAYMENT LIMITATION. The legislative council shall consider studying, during the 2003-04 interim, the provisions of section 54-17.2-23 of the North Dakota Century Code regarding the statutory limitation on the amount of capital construction lease payments paid from the general fund and the effect of increasing the percentage limitation. The legislative council shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the fifty-ninth legislative assembly.

30 **SECTION 4. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
