ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2008

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the public service

2 commission; to provide for repayment of funding; to provide for a legislative council study; and

3 to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 6 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 7 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 8 other income, to the public service commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the 9 public service commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005, 10 as follows: 11 Salaries and wages \$4,771,497 12 1,137,006 Operating expenses 13 Capital assets 35,011 14 Grants 62,000 15 Abandoned mined lands contractual services 3,668,492 16 Rail rate complaint case 250,000 17 Total all funds \$9,924,006 18 Less estimated income 6,072,767 19 Total general fund appropriation \$3,851,239 20 SECTION 2. SPECIAL FUNDS TRANSFER. The less estimated income line item in

section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$200,000, or so much of the sum as may be

22 necessary, from the state rail fund, maintained by the department of transportation under

23 section 49-17.1-02.1, and \$50,000 from other sources, to pay the costs associated with the

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- initial stage of a rail rate complaint case. The commission shall collect the \$50,000 before
 proceeding with the initial stage of the rail rate complaint case.
- SECTION 3. REPAYMENT OF FUNDING. The public service commission shall
 reimburse the state rail fund for any amounts transferred from proceeds that may result from a
 successful outcome of the rail rate study and rail rate complaint case.
 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION
 DUTIES AND FUNDING. The legislative council shall consider studying, during the 2003-04
 interim, the feasibility and desirability of transferring inspection and standards functions
 conducted by various state agencies to the public service commission, including the potential
- 10 cost-savings and efficiencies that may be realized by training and certifying employees to
- 11 conduct multiple inspection duties. In addition, the study, if conducted, must include an
- 12 examination of the feasibility and desirability of funding the public service commission entirely
- 13 from special fund revenue sources. The legislative council shall report its findings and
- 14 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 15 the fifty-ninth legislative assembly.
- SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. The rail rate complaint case line item in section 1 and
 section 2 of this Act are declared to be an emergency measure.
