- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the department of
- 2 human services; to provide for the transfer of appropriation authority between agencies and
- 3 institutions; and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the	ŧ
6	funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state	е
7	treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and	
8	other income, to the department of human services and its various divisions, for the purpose of	
9	defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending	
10	June 30, 2005, as follows:

25	SECTION 2. LANDS AND MINERALS TRUST FUND. The	sum of \$2,261,556, or so	
26	much of the sum as may be necessary, included in the development	tally disabled facility loan	
27	fund line item in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act, may be expended by the department of		
28	human services from the lands and minerals trust fund for the purpose of making payments of		
29	principal and interest to the common schools trust fund on any loans made from it pursuant to		
30	the developmentally disabled loan fund program nos. 2 and 3, for the biennium beginning		
31	July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005.		

I	SECTION 3. CORRELATION OF RESOURCES FOR DEPARTMENTAL CLIENTS
2	AND FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS. The director of the department of human
3	services may transfer appropriation authority and authorized positions between agencies and
4	institutions included within subdivision 3 of section 1 of this Act to correlate fiscal and staff
5	resources with the flow of institutional residents and human service center clients between
6	community-based programs and institutions. Any transfer from a human service center
7	requires prior consultation with the respective regional human service center advisory board.
8	As determined necessary by the director of the department of human services, the director may
9	hire full-time equivalent positions, in addition to those authorized by the legislative assembly
10	pursuant to the appropriation in subdivision 3 of section 1 of this Act, for the biennium beginning
11	July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005.
12	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY. The state hospital line item in subdivision 3 of section 1 of
13	this Act includes \$400,000 from special funds for capital construction projects, and the
14	appropriation of that amount is declared to be an emergency measure.
