1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the game and fish

2 department; and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 5 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the game and fish fund in 6 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal 7 funds and other income, to the game and fish department for the purpose of defraying the 8 expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005, 9 as follows: 10 Salaries and wages \$15,282,264 11 9,416,219 Operating expenses 12 Capital assets 2,259,944 13 Grants 3,602,050 14 Land habitat and deer depredation 6,886,245 15 Noxious weed control 300,000 16 Grants, gifts, and donations 150,000 17 Nongame wildlife conservation 120,000 18 Lonetree reservoir 1,342,951 19 Wildlife services 400,000 20 Total special funds appropriation \$39,759,673 21 SECTION 2. PRIVATE LAND HABITAT AND ACCESS IMPROVEMENT. The sum of 22 \$3,873,386, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, included in the land habitat and deer

23 depredation line item in section 1 of this Act, is from the private land habitat and access

24 improvement fund and shall be used by the game and fish department for the private land

habitat and access improvement program, as provided in section 20.1-02-05, for the biennium
 beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005.

SECTION 3. NONGAME WILDLIFE. The sum of \$41,874, or so much of the sum as
may be necessary, included in the nongame wildlife line item in section 1 of this Act, is from the
nongame wildlife fund and shall be used by the game and fish department for the purposes
provided in section 20.1-02-16.2, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30,
2005.

8 SECTION 4. WILDLIFE SERVICES - AGRICULTURE COMMISSIONER. The sum of 9 \$400,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, included in the wildlife services line 10 item in section 1 of this Act, is from the game and fish department operating fund and must be 11 provided to the agriculture commissioner to pay for services provided by the United States 12 department of agriculture wildlife services agency to alleviate wildlife depredation and damage 13 in North Dakota. Projects, contracts, and agreements relating to the expenditure of these 14 moneys must be approved by the director of the game and fish department. 15 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY.
