SENATE BILL NO. 2113
(Senators Lyson, Fischer)
(Representatives Ruby, Onstad)

AN ACT to provide for a legislative council study of hunting and fishing privileges for nonresidents and nonresidents who are former residents.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL - NONRESIDENT HUNTER STUDY. The legislative council shall consider studying, during the 2005-06 interim, issues related to hunting and fishing by nonresidents and nonresidents who are former residents. The legislative council shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixtieth legislative assembly.
