

**HOUSE BILL NO. 1397**

1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota  
2 Century Code, relating to opportunities for the enrollment of students in a veterinary medical  
3 education program; and to provide an appropriation.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
6 created and enacted as follows:

7 **Veterinary medical education program - Kansas state university - Contract.**

- 8 1. In addition to any contracts under section 15-10-28.2, the state board of higher  
9 education may contract with Kansas state university to provide an opportunity for  
10 up to ten eligible students to enroll in the veterinary medical education program at  
11 Kansas state university.
- 12 2. Eligible students must be residents of this state and must have been selected for  
13 enrollment by an admissions committee consisting of one faculty member from the  
14 department of veterinary and microbiological sciences at North Dakota state  
15 university, one veterinarian practicing in this state, one member of the legislative  
16 assembly, and one livestock producer, all of whom must be appointed by the  
17 legislative council, and the chairman of the admissions committee at the Kansas  
18 state university school of veterinary medicine.
- 19 3. The admissions committee shall determine the criteria to be used in the selection  
20 of eligible students.
- 21 4. As a condition of selection under this program, an eligible student shall agree to  
22 practice veterinary medicine in this state for a period of three years upon  
23 graduation. If a student fails to fulfill the commitment for practice in this state, the

1 student shall repay to the state board of higher education all moneys forwarded to  
2 or for the student under this Act, on a proportionate basis.

3 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the  
4 general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$525,000, or so much  
5 of the sum as may be necessary, to the state board of higher education for the purpose of  
6 reducing the amount of tuition and other costs payable by or on behalf of eligible students  
7 enrolled in the veterinary medical education program at Kansas state university under this Act,  
8 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007.
