SENATE BILL NO. 2234
(Senators Kringstad, Hacker)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 5-02-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the dispensing of alcoholic beverages on certain days.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 5-02-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

5-02-05. Dispensing prohibited on certain days - Penalty. ~~Any~~ A person ~~who dispenses~~ may not dispense or permits permit the consumption of alcoholic beverages on a licensed premises ~~after between~~ between one a.m. ~~on Sundays, before and~~ and twelve noon on Sundays, ~~or between the hours of~~ or between the hours of one a.m. and eight a.m. on all other days of the week, ~~or who dispenses alcoholic beverages or permits consumption of alcoholic beverages on licensed premises on Christmas Day, after one a.m. on Thanksgiving Day, or after six p.m. on Christmas Eve.~~ In addition, a person may not provide off-sale after one a.m. on Thanksgiving Day. A person that violates this section is guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
