1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to school reporting of student progress and achievement.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 created and enacted as follows:

6 **State assessments - Report to parents.** Upon the release of state assessment
7 results by the superintendent of public instruction, each school shall issue a report to the
8 parents of each student. The superintendent of public instruction shall format the report to
9 contain the student's individual test scores and a grade-level equivalent based on the state
10 standards. The information must be presented in a fashion that allows the student's parent to
11 easily compare the student's progress and achievement to that of others:

- 12 1. In the student's classroom;
- 13 2. At the same grade level in the student's school and school district;
- 14 3. At the same grade level in contiguous school districts; and
- 15 4. At the same grade level in noncontiguous school districts of similar size.
