

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4010

Introduced by

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study alternatives to the current
2 method of expressing property tax levies in mills per dollar of taxable valuation.

3 **WHEREAS**, property taxes levied by the state and political subdivisions are expressed
4 in mills per dollar of taxable valuation of property; and

5 **WHEREAS**, converting mills per dollar of taxable valuation into actual property taxes
6 against market value of property is difficult and confusing; and

7 **WHEREAS**, converting property tax levies into an understandable measure, such as tax
8 dollars per one thousand dollars of market value, would allow citizens to understand property
9 tax levies and judge how property taxes will impact them;

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE**
11 **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:**

12 That the Legislative Council study alternatives to the current method of expressing
13 property tax levies in mills per dollar of taxable valuation; and

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
15 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
16 the Sixtieth Legislative Assembly.
