

SENATE MEMORIAL RESOLUTION NO. 8001

1 A memorial resolution for deceased members of the Senate of North Dakota.

2 **WHEREAS**, God has summoned to eternal rest our former colleagues:

3 Linda Christenson, who served in the 57th and 58th Legislative Assemblies, from
4 District 18, died July 28, 2004;

5 Glenn R. Dolan, who served in the 34th and 35th Legislative Assemblies, from District 2,
6 died May 1, 2004;

7 Walter C. Erdman, who served in the 42nd through the 46th Legislative Assemblies,
8 from District 6, died September 25, 2004;

9 Donald C. Holand, who served in the 34th through the 39th Legislative Assemblies, from
10 District 14; in the 40th and 41st Legislative Assemblies, from District 27; and in the 42nd and
11 43rd Legislative Assemblies, from District 21; died December 26, 2003;

12 Joe B. Leibhan, who served in the 47th and 48th Legislative Assemblies, from
13 District 12, died February 22, 2004;

14 Evan E. Lips, who served in the 37th through the 39th Legislative Assemblies, from
15 District 27; in the 40th through the 44th Legislative Assemblies, from District 32; and in the
16 45th through the 55th Legislative Assemblies, from District 47; died January 9, 2005;

17 Corliss Mushik, who served in the 49th through the 54th Legislative Assemblies, from
18 District 34, died July 4, 2004;

19 Ron Quail, who served in the 47th Legislative Assembly, from District 38, died June 4,
20 2003;

21 Leland Roen, who served in the 35th through the 43rd Legislative Assemblies, and the
22 46th and 47th Legislative Assemblies, from District 39, died May 22, 2003; and

23 **WHEREAS**, we now pause to mourn the passing of our former Senate colleagues and
24 to honor their memories; and

1 **WHEREAS**, these legislators rendered outstanding service to the people of the state by
2 their contributions to public service;

3 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 That we express our sorrow on their passing and our appreciation, on behalf of the
5 people of North Dakota, of the loyal and devoted service of our former colleagues; and

6 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that for the perpetuation of their memory this token of
7 respect and sympathy by their successors in trust be printed in the Journal of the Senate and
8 that the Secretary of State present enrolled copies of this resolution to the surviving families of
9 these deceased senators.
