1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the Indian affairs
2 commission.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION.** The amounts identified in this
5 section represent the base level funding component appropriated to the Indian affairs
6 commission in section 3 of this Act as follows:

7 Salaries and wages	\$314,311
8 Operating expenses	<u>40,932</u>
9 Total general fund - Base level	\$355,243

10 **SECTION 2. FUNDING ADJUSTMENTS OR ENHANCEMENTS INFORMATION.** The
11 amounts identified in this section represent the funding adjustments or enhancements to the
12 base funding level for the Indian affairs commission which are included in the appropriation in
13 section 3 of this Act as follows:

14 Salaries and wages	\$28,022
15 Operating expenses	<u>22,963</u>
16 Total all funds - Adjustments/enhancements	\$50,985
17 Less estimated income - Adjustments/enhancements	<u>20,000</u>
18 Total general fund - Adjustments/enhancements	\$30,985

19 **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
20 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
21 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
22 other income, to the Indian affairs commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that
23 agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007, as follows:
