## ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2022

(At the request of the Governor)

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state seed  
2 department.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION.** The amounts identified in this  
5 section represent the base level funding component appropriated to the state seed department  
6 in section 3 of this Act as follows:

14 amounts identified in this section represent the funding adjustments or enhancements to the  
15 base funding level for the state seed department which are included in the appropriation in  
16 section 3 of this Act as follows:
