ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2023

Introduced by

Appropriations Committee

(At the request of the Governor)

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for capital projects of various state departments;
2 to provide an appropriation for state facility energy improvement capital projects of various state
3 departments and institutions; to authorize the industrial commission to issue and sell evidences
4 of indebtedness for capital projects; to provide for a legislative council study; and to declare an
5 emergency.

6 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

7 **SECTION 1. PROJECT AUTHORIZATIONS.** The industrial commission, acting as the
8 North Dakota building authority, shall arrange for the funding of the projects authorized in this
9 section, declared to be in the public interest, through the issuance of evidences of
10 indebtedness under chapter 54-17.2, beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending
11 June 30, 2007. The industrial commission shall issue evidences of indebtedness under this
12 section with the condition that lease rental payments need not begin until July 1, 2007. The
13 authority of the industrial commission to issue evidences of indebtedness under this section
14 ends June 30, 2007, but the industrial commission may continue to exercise all other powers
15 granted to it under chapter 54-17.2 and this Act and comply with any covenants entered into
16 before that date. The proceeds of the evidences of indebtedness and other available funds are
17 appropriated to the agencies listed in this section, beginning with the effective date of this Act
18 and ending June 30, 2007, for the following projects:

14 The north central research center may obtain and utilize federal and other funds to
15 assist in the construction of an agronomy laboratory at the north central research center. There
16 is appropriated to the north central research center the sum of \$1,250,000, or so much of the
17 sum as may be necessary, from any federal acts, private grants, gifts and donations, or other
18 funds that may become available for this project for the biennium beginning the effective date of
19 this Act and ending June 30, 2007.

20 The main research center may obtain and utilize federal funds and other funds to assist
21 in the construction of a greenhouse complex at the main research center. There is
22 appropriated to the main research center the sum of \$5,000,000, or so much of the sum as may
23 be necessary, from any federal acts, private grants, gifts and donations, or other funds that may
24 become available for this project for the biennium beginning the effective date of this Act and
25 ending June 30, 2007.

26 The state historical society may obtain and utilize federal funds to assist in the
27 renovation and addition at the chateau interpretive center. There is appropriated to the state
28 historical society the sum of \$500,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, for any
29 federal or other funds that may become available for this project for the biennium beginning the
30 effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2007.

3 **SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY - DEFERRED MAINTENANCE -**

4 **INFRASTRUCTURE - HERITAGE CENTER.** The legislative council shall consider studying,
5 during the 2005-06 interim, deferred maintenance and infrastructure for all state agencies and
6 institutions and compile a list of all the deferred maintenance and long-term infrastructure
7 needs. This study must include the long-term needs of the North Dakota heritage center. The
8 legislative council shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation
9 required to implement the recommendations, to the sixtieth legislative assembly.

10 **SECTION 5. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
