

HOUSE BILL NO. 1114

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 26.1-18.1-08 of the North Dakota Century
2 Code, relating to annual reports filed by health maintenance organizations.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 26.1-18.1-08 of the North Dakota Century Code
5 is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **26.1-18.1-08. Annual report.**

- 7 1. Every domestic health maintenance organization shall annually, on or before
8 March first, and every foreign health maintenance organization shall annually, on
9 or before the date that its annual report is due in its domestic state, file a report
10 verified by at least two principal officers with the commissioner, covering the
11 preceding calendar year. The report must be on forms prescribed by the
12 commissioner. In addition, the domestic health maintenance organization shall file
13 by March first, and every foreign health maintenance organization shall file
14 annually, on or before the date that its annual report is due in its domestic state,
15 unless otherwise stated:
- 16 a. Audited financial statements on or before June first.
 - 17 b. A list of the providers who have executed a contract that complies with
18 subdivision a of subsection 4 of section 26.1-18.1-12.
 - 19 c. (1) A description of the grievance procedures.
20 (2) The total number of grievances handled through the procedures, a
21 compilation of the causes underlying those grievances, and a summary
22 of the final disposition of those grievances.
- 23 2. The commissioner may require additional reports as are deemed necessary and
24 appropriate to enable the commissioner to carry out the commissioner's duties

- 1 under this chapter. The commissioner may waive the filing of the annual report
2 and other information for a health maintenance organization that has discontinued
3 its operation in this state.
- 4 3. The commissioner may designate the national association of insurance
5 commissioners as the repository for the filing of the annual report.
