This bill increases the fee for antlered whitetail deer hunting licenses from \$20 to \$40 and decreases the fee for antlerless whitetail license from \$20 to \$10. The price for mule deer licenses remains at \$20.

The \$20 increase for the whitetail antlered licenses will produce about \$800,000 dollars in additional revenue per year. This uses 40,000 as the total number of licenses involved and assumes that both whitetail buck and any antlered licenses have a \$40 fee.

The reduction in price for the antlerless whitetailed deer licenses reduces revenue by \$800,000 based on 80,000 licenses per year. The increase in fees for antlered whitetail licenses is offset by the fee reduction for antlerless licenses. The bill is revenue neutral based on 2004 license numbers.
