4 SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION. The amounts identified in this 5 section represent the base level funding component appropriated to the Indian affairs 6 commission in section 3 of this Act as follows: 7 Salaries and wages \$314,311 8 Operating expenses 40,932 9 Total general fund - Base level \$355.243 10 SECTION 2. FUNDING ADJUSTMENTS OR ENHANCEMENTS INFORMATION. The 11 amounts identified in this section represent the funding adjustments or enhancements to the 12 base funding level for the Indian affairs commission which are included in the appropriation in 13 section 3 of this Act as follows: 14 \$28,022 Salaries and wages 15 Operating expenses 22,963 16 Total all funds - Adjustments/enhancements \$50,985 17 Less estimated income - Adjustments/enhancements 20,000 \$30,985 18 Total general fund - Adjustments/enhancements 19 **SECTION 3.** APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 20 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 21 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 22 other income, to the Indian affairs commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that 23 agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007, as follows:
