4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION. The amounts identified in this 6 section represent the base level funding component appropriated to the state fair association in 7 section 3 of this Act as follows:

6 SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 4-02.1-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is
7 amended and reenacted as follows:

8 4-02.1-09. Vacancies and special compensation of board members. Any vacancy 9 occurring on the board of directors must be filled by the board of directors for the unexpired 10 term of the vacancy. The board of directors may not receive any salary for their services, but, 11 by resolution of the board, per diem payments of ten dollars and travel expenses not exceeding 12 such amounts as allowed other state officials and employees, may be allowed for attendance at 13 each regular or special meeting of the board or members. The board of directors has the 14 power, in its discretion, to may contract for and to pay directors rendering unusual or 15 exceptional services to the association, special compensation appropriate to the value of such

16 services.
