- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the information
- 2 technology department; to amend and reenact subsection 4 of section 54-59-05 of the North
- 3 Dakota Century Code, relating to the powers and duties of the information technology
- 4 department; and to declare an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. BASE LEVEL FUNDING INFORMATION. The amounts identified in this
7 section represent the base level funding component appropriated to the information technology
8 department in section 3 of this Act as follows:

17 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 18 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 19 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 20 other income, to the information technology department for the purpose of defraying the 21 expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007, 22 as follows: 23 Salaries and wages \$29,200,029 24 **Operating expenses** 48,913,676

4	SECTION 4. TRANSFERS. Notwithstanding section 5	4-16-04, the director of the off

4 SECTION 4. TRANSFERS. Notwithstanding section 54-16-04, the director of the office 5 of management and budget and the state treasurer shall make transfers of funds between line 6 items in section 3 of this Act for the information technology department as may be requested by 7 the chief information officer as determined necessary for the development and implementation 8 of the medicaid management information system. Any increase in full-time equivalent positions 9 needed for this project must be reported to the director of the office of management and budget 10 during the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2007.

SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 54-59-05 of the North Dakota
 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

13 May purchase, finance the purchase, or lease equipment, software, or 4. 14 implementation services or replace, including by trade or resale, equipment or 15 software as may be necessary to carry out this chapter. An agreement to finance 16 the purchase of software, equipment, or implementation services may not exceed a 17 period of three five years. The department shall submit any intended financing 18 proposal for the purchase of software, equipment, or implementation services 19 under this subsection, which is in excess of one million dollars, to the budget 20 section of the legislative council or the legislative assembly before executing a 21 financing agreement. If the budget section or the legislative assembly does not 22 approve the execution of a financing agreement, the department may not proceed 23 with the proposed financing arrangement. The department may finance the 24 purchase of software, equipment, or implementation services only to the extent the 25 purchase amount does not exceed seven and one-half percent of the amount 26 appropriated to the department during that biennium. 27 **SECTION 6. EMERGENCY.** Section 5 of this Act is declared to be an emergency
